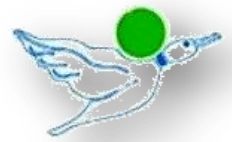


NOTICE

IMPORTANT CLUB RULES



THE GOLF CLUB IS PRIVATELY OWNED & MANAGED. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES MAY RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE GOLF COURSE:

- **NO** CASUAL, INFORMAL PLAYING IS PERMITTED ON THE COURSE
- **NO** ONE IS PERMITTED ON THE COURSE AFTER HOURS
- **NO** ONE IS PERMITTED TO SEARCH FOR OR REMOVE BALLS FROM THE COURSE
- **NO** DRIVING OF ANY GOLF CARTS WITHOUT A VALID DRIVERS LICENCE
- **ALL** GOLF GAMES TO BE PREPAID AT PROSHOP

ETIQUETTE

- Please respect the golf course conditions by raking bunkers, repairing your pitch marks, replacing divots and filling with sand and use the bins provided. Cigarettes to be discarded in the bins provided on the tee boxes
- Sand bags and divot tools are compulsory
- Please use appropriate golf etiquette and respect the golf course property and private property that surrounds the golf course
- Proper golf attire is required and **SOFT SPIKES ONLY**
- Maximum of 4 players per covey
- Allow faster players to play through if the hole ahead is clear
- All players to have own set of clubs and bag – rental equipment is available at the proshop

GOLF

- The proshop reserves the right to create four-balls or three-balls
- If lightening is present, vacate the course immediately
- No practicing on the golf course at any time
- Halfway stop of 10 minutes is compulsory
- 18-holes: 4 hrs 20 min pace of play policy – course marshals will assist in maintaining this
- 9-holes: 2 hrs 10 min
- Please preserve the fynbos
- No one shall play on the course unless they have registered at the proshop first & have a dated till slip
- Absolutely no starting in the middle of the course
- Children under 12 may not enter the golf course unless accompanied by an adult or playing golf with the club's consent
- A max of 2 people in a cart – exception may be for kids 5 yrs and younger (& private 4-seater carts)
- All carts to be kept at least 5m from greens and tee boxes
- Members, their guests and or invitees may only play golf on the golf course with the approval and subject to the rules and regulations imposed by the golf club
- Members, guests and or invitees who enter the golf course, do so at their own risk
- Persons entering the golf course must at all times observe the etiquette of golf
- No person may walk on any green, tee or bunker on the golf course unless playing golf with the approval of the club
- No persons shall permit their domestic animals to walk on the golf course
- Golfers must comply with the Course Management and/or Marshal's instructions. Failure to do so will result in removal from the course.

Anyone failing to adhere to any of the above or violating any rules may be removed from the course and may have golf privileges and/or membership suspended without refund
